

Pendleton Underground Comes ALIVE!

Eastern Oregon history comes ALIVE: Tours of the Underground, Woolen Mill, Hot Lake Springs Bronze Foundry & Oregon Trail Interpretive Center plus two nights at Wildhorse Resort & Casino

Thursday, May 17 – Depart early AM on a restroom-equipped, deluxe, Moffit motorcoach. We travel via the scenic Columbia Gorge with lunch enroute. Afternoon tour of the Pendleton Woolen Mills with a late afternoon arrival at Wildhorse Resort & Casino. New Tower room accommodations for two nights. Dinner is on-your-own. Perhaps attend the Wildhorse Comedy Jam at 8pm.

Friday, May 18 – Breakfast on-your-own at Wildhorse. Morning travel through the Blue Mtns to Hot Lake Springs. We tour the bronze foundry. Lunch is included. During the afternoon we travel to Baker City and tour the Oregon Trail National Interpretive Center. We return to Wildhorse Resort & Casino for on-your-own dinner, gaming and live music entertainment.

Saturday, May 19 – Breakfast on-your-own at Wildhorse. Morning travel to downtown Pendleton where over 75 local actors bring the Underground to life in a once-yearly show. Card players, dancers, music, Chinese workers, merchants from the past are all there to greet you and reenact what would have taken place over 100 years ago. Visit with the Madam "Stella" and her working girls and other special people in the Cozy Room bordello. Lunch enroute included with an early evening return to Salem.

Lodging

The new, 10-story Tower rooms at Wildhorse Resort opened September 2011. In-room amenities include a coffee maker, microwave, refrigerator, hair dryer, flat-screen TV and Sister Sky bath products. Other Resort amenities include a pool and a 5-screen movie theatre complete with 3-D screens. Choose between smoking or non-smoking rooms and one king or double queen Serta Prestige double plush mattresses.
