

Historic Peoples King Tut...Returns & Tillicum Village

Friday, August 17 – Depart early AM on a deluxe motorcoach (restroom-equipped) for Seattle's Pacific Science Center. Lunch is on-you-own upon arrival. For the King Tut exhibit, we have timed admission tickets to eliminate long waits/ lines. This afternoon, enjoy viewing over 100 rare artifacts attributed to King Tutankhamun and other Golden Age pharaohs, spanning nearly 2000 years of history. Included are a personalized audio guide (read by Harrison Ford) and an IMAX movie describing the historic pyramids.

This evening, we have an Italian feast served family-style at nearby Buca di Beppo.

Overnight lodging at Four Points by Sheraton – Downtown Seattle Center.

Saturday, August 18 – A voucher is provided for a morning meal at the hotel. The morning is free to celebrate Seattle Center's 50th anniversary; Space Needle, Monorail or the new Chihuly Glass House & Gardens. At 11am we depart for a narrated Puget Sound cruise to Tillicum Village on Blake Island. Our 4-hour event includes a welcome appetizer, salmon bbq buffet, a Native American-inspired program and exploration time. Upon return to Seattle's waterfront we depart for home. Expected return is early evening.
